The world of work: P4+

As we explore backstage and front of house, this tour will focus on the different jobs that our teams at the theatre and concert hall do. EXA 2-14a, HWB 2-20

Perth history: P4+

Discover the history of Perth Theatre and the role that it has played in the city of Perth. EXA 2-13a

Workshops Our experienced artists are available to visit your schools to lead workshops.

All workshops will last 1.5 hours and are for up to 30 pupils at a time (2 per day max).

Exploring worlds: P1 - P3

Let's use our imaginations to explore different lands! Thinking about the way we move and different characters as we go. EXA 1-12a, EXA 1-14a

Creating characters: P3-P7

Work with our theatre artists to create and transform into new characters. How do they walk, talk and feel? What is life like from their eyes? EXA 2 - 12a.

Creating stories: P3 - 7

How do we create stories that the audience will understand? Work with our artists to create new, potentially crazy stories and bring them to life. EXA 2-12a EXA 2 - 14a

The world of work: P5 - 7

Who works at the theatre? From carpenters to cleaners, actors to accountants. Every skill is vital for the show to go on. In this interactive workshop, your class will explore potential careers in the arts. EXA 2-14a, HWB 2-20

CPD Our CPD sessions take place year round throughout Perth and Kinross.

Storytelling using drama

How do we use drama to explore books, periods of history or world events? Our artists will lead you through multiple ways in this session.

Creating characters and stories using drama

Our artist will take you through a simple step by step process of using drama games and techniques, that will result in the creation of new characters and stories.

Object as inspiration

How can we use everyday objects in drama? How can they be the starting point for stories and creative writing? How can we use them on stage to create different settings?
